Your input is requested in identifying a team from a New York City school of your choice.

Eligibility Requirements

- New York City schools with afterschool programs located in their school buildings and taking place immediately after the school day ends
- The relationships between schools and afterschool programs cannot have been formally designed into the schools' mission and structure. (E.g. New Visions Schools)
- Partnerships must have been in existence for 3 years or more
- Winners (principals and CBO managers) must be available to attend the awards ceremony at the Leadership Academy on July 29th, 2009.
- Winners must be willing to be profiled in PASE's communications materials.

Selection Criteria

- Both organizations must have worked together on forming and maintaining an active collaboration with shared goals for the program
- The program demonstrates a strong integration between the school day and the afterschool program
- The programs are distinct but complementary
- There are existing mechanisms for shared decision-making related to program operations

Nominations Process

Nominations may be made by anyone knowledgeable about the partnership. They should be submitted in the form of a letter addressed to PASE, Exemplary Partnership Award, 120 Broadway, Ste 230, New York, NY. 10271 or by fax to 212-571-2676.

The letter must address the extent to which the nominees have met the selection criteria described above, providing specific examples in each case.

Nominations will close at 5:00 pm on Thursday, July 2, 2009.
